GENERAL OVERVIEW AND CONCEPT FOR PROCUREMENT OF VARIOUS ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION 8(A) ENVIRONMENTAL AWARD CONTRACT (EMAC)

1.1 GENERAL OVERVIEW AND CONCEPT FOR AWARD OF ENVIRONMENTAL MULTIPLE AWARD CONTRACT (EMAC)

Through this solicitation, the Government seeks to fulfill varying environmental remediation requirements at the below mentioned activities/locations. This solicitation could result in the award of an Environmental Multiple Award Contract (EMAC) of up to four Indefinite Quantity Contracts with firm fixed price task orders; although the Government reserves the right to award less than four (4) contracts, based upon its discretion. Award of the seed project will be made to the firm offering the proposal considered most advantageous to the Government, price and other factors considered. The remaining up to three (3) EMAC contracts may be made to those firms whose proposals conforming to this RFP, are considered to be most advantageous to the Government as a result of the Best Value evaluation, price and other factors considered. The task orders under the EMAC contract will be issued for various environmental remediation projects. Request for Proposal procedures will be utilized for this procurement. This solicitation incorporates a seed project upon which all proposals will be evaluated for award.

1.2 PLACE OF PERFORMANCE

Performance of work will be in the 12 states area of CT, DE, MA, MD, ME, NH, NJ, NY, PA, RI, VA and VT with a preponderance of work to be performed in the DE, MD, NJ, NY, PA and VA areas. The seed project is located at the Naval Support Station, Mechanicsburg, Pennsylvania.

1.3 DESCRIPTION OF WORK REQUIREMENTS

The work requirements under this solicitation will include various environmental remediations. Projects may include asbestos abatement, lead paint hazardous control, underground storage tank removal/replacements, demolition and limited soil removals. Projects may also require developing documentation such as work plans, health and safety plans and closeout reports. The seed project includes the removal/replacement and construction of secondary containment for above ground storage tanks. The estimated cost range for this seed project is \$100,000 to \$250,000. Davis Bacon Wages will be applicable to this project.

1.4 CONTRACT AWARD

This solicitation may result in the award of an Environmental Multiple Award Contract (EMAC) of up to four (4) separate Indefinite Quantity Contracts encompassing a five (5) year performance period during which separate Task Orders for environmental remediation projects will be issued. This solicitation will contain an initial or seed project, which if awarded to one of the up to four successful contractors, will become Task Order 0001. The firm offering the proposal considered most advantageous to the government will receive the seed project, price and other factors considered. The remaining up to three (3) EMAC contracts may be awarded to those responsible offerors whose proposals conforming to this RFP, are considered to be the most advantageous to the Government as a result of the Best Value evaluation, price and other factors considered and will contain a minimum guarantee of \$50 thousand over the five years of contract performance. Subsequent Task Order will be competed only among the up to four successful contractors. Award of each Task Order may be based on either Best Value to the Government or low price. The maximum not to exceed amount for this EMAC contract is \$15 million. A bid guarantee in the amount of \$200,000 to remain in effect until such time as the first Task Order is issued under each of the up to four (4) EMAC contracts that may be awarded as a result of this solicitation. The bid guarantee will be required to be submitted with the price proposal. The anticipated range for each Task Order will generally be between \$25,000 and \$1,000,000. The Request for Proposal
