Subj: VOYAGER PAYMENT DELINQUENCIES

We have recently been advised that a number of navy activities are seriously delinquent in paying their Voyager accounts and are in jeopardy of having their privileges suspended until their accounts are brought up-to-date. In accordance with the terms and conditions of the GSA Master Contract, any account that is 120 days past due can be deactivated. This action would be devastating to our mission. We remind all Certifying officials that it is their responsibility to certify that the transactions are true and that the properly executed invoice is transmitted promptly to the appropriate DFAS Office. DFAS has been reminded of the importance of the DoD Fleet Credit Card and the consequences of non-payment. Please make sure your accounts are paid in full.
