DESCRIPTION, SPECIFICATIONS, AND WORK STATEMENT

1. **AREA OF COVERAGE:** The Contractor shall provide an on-call, as-needed basis rental of construction type equipment to all activities, installations and organizations which are part of the Department of the Navy and /or other Federal Government Agencies located within the 48 contiguous states of the United States of America. Excluded are the states of Alaska and Hawaii, Commonwealth of Puerto Rico and those Territories and Possessions of the United States of America. The intent of this contract is to provide the Government with an efficient and responsive means to obtain construction type equipment to meet short-term agency requirements for, including but not limited to, unanticipated surges, contingencies, disaster recovery, seasonal use, etc.

1.1 Under contingency conditions, heavy construction equipment may be required at locations outside the 48 contiguous United States (ie. Guam, Diego Garcia, Hawaii, Caribbean, and Mediterranean Ocean areas). Under these circumstances, the equipment, with the contractor's written permission, may be sent to these locations. The Government will be responsible for any ocean transportation costs. The Government will take full responsibility for property damage liability while the equipment is physically located off the 48 contiguous United States.

2. **EQUIPMENT DESCRIPTION:** All construction type equipment and attachments listed in Exhibit A shall be offered to the Department of the Navy as part of this contract. As defined by NAVFAC P-300, Management of Civil Engineering Support Equipment, construction equipment means all mechanical equipment used in the construction, alteration, or repair of buildings, bridges, roads, or other kinds of real property. Specific categories or types of construction equipment for use in this contract are identified as follows:

2.1 **CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT CATEGORIES:** The following types of construction equipment desired for rental off this contract are (1) Earthmoving and Excavation Equipment, (2) Material Handling Equipment, (3) Aerial Equipment, (4) Compaction and Paving Equipment, (5) Pumping Equipment, (6) Air Compressor Equipment, (7) Electrical Equipment, (8) Concrete and Masonry Equipment, and (9) Truck and Trailer Equipment. Rental equipment shall not exceed four (4) years old.

3. **DELIVERY:** Delivery of rental equipment will be delivered to the requester site no later than seventy-two (72) hours from receipt of delivery order at the contractor site. The contractor shall confirm delivery order acceptance at time of receipt either by facsimile transmission, electronic mail, or by telephone to the equipment requester. Contractor delivery orders may be issued from a centrally managed location or regional locations. Contractor must provide service twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week including all State and Federal Holidays, to insure coverage for all unknown emergencies and contingencies which may be experienced by the equipment requestor.

3.1 **CONTRACTOR EQUIPMENT – "RENTAL RELEASE NUMBERS":** All rental users of this contract will be issued a Rental Release Number at the specific time requested by the user for turn-in to the Contractor. The rental release number establishes the exact time the rental equipment comes off the Contractor's rental record regardless of when the Contractor picks up and returns the rental equipment to the Contractor's site. Rental Release Numbers will be required in all cases of dispute regarding release time and date.

3.2 **EQUIPMENT SECURITY RESPONSIBILITIES ON GOVERNMENT PROPERTY:** The participating Department of the Navy installation, activity or organization or other contracted Government Agency is required to safeguard and provide equipment security for rental equipment while in the custody of the user and upon release from the Contractor, after issue of a "Rental Release Number" for the following periods of time: (1) Two (2) working days, and Five (5) working days if the rental units are greater than 200 miles from the nearest contractor location.

3.3 **RENTAL EQUIPMENT PERIOD:** The rental equipment period begins when the rental unit arrives on site and is inspected and accepted by the user to be safe and serviceable. The rental period ends when requestor receives a Rental Release Number from Contractor.

3.4 DESTINATION DELIVERY: Contractor shall provide delivery and pick up of all rental equipment based on a predetermined per mile delivery charge. Deliveries within the continental United States are f.o.b. destination. Deliveries outside the continental United States are f.o.b. origin.

3.5 MAXIMUM RENTAL PERIOD: The rental of all construction type equipment shall not exceed one hundred eighty (180) calendar days.

4. MAINTENANCE OF RENTAL EQUIPMENT: The Contractor shall provide all maintenance and repair of all rental equipment at no cost to the Government. All maintenance and repair of rental equipment shall be provided by the contractor at the location /site of the rental equipment. Rental equipment which cannot reasonably be repaired at the location /site during the rental period, as determined by the Contractor shall be replaced at no cost to the Government, within three (3) working days of the Contractors determination or five (5) working days if rental equipment is located 200 miles or more from Contractors nearest location. The Contractor shall provide all minor and major warranty and manufacturers safety recall repairs on rented equipment, as determined and scheduled by the Contractor. The contractor shall be responsible for components/parts needing replacement due to normal wear and tear. Also, preventive maintenance required of the rental equipment, excluding maintenance of required operating fluids, shall be provided by the Contractor at no additional cost to the Government.

4.1 REPLACEMENT OF RENTAL EQUIPMENT: Replacement of any piece of rental equipment that is determined to be non-repairable at the requesters location/site, shall be treated in the identical venue specified in paragraphs 1 through 4 of this section including all related subparagraphs, depending on equipment availability at the time.

4.2 REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE: All repairs and maintenance of rental equipment shall be performed by the Contractor. Trained Contractor service technicians shall be dispatched to the requester's location/site upon receiving equipment repair trouble call.

5. SERVICE CALLS AND EMERGENCY REPAIRS: The Contractor shall provide twenty-four (24) hour emergency repair service at all of the national rental locations.

5.1 SERVICE/EMERGENCY SERVICE CALL RESPONSE TIMES: Routine service calls placed by the requester for rental equipment shall be made by telephone, electronic mail or facsimile transmission to the Contractor and shall be immediately acknowledged by the Contractor of receipt. Service calls received and acknowledged by the contractor for user locations that are less than two hundred (200) miles shall have a service unit on site within four (4) hours. For user locations that are greater than two hundred miles (200), the contractor shall have a service unit on site no later than one twenty-four (24) day. Emergency service calls shall be handled in the same manner prescribed above however all effort shall be made by the contractor to accommodate and satisfy the emergency as expeditiously as possible. Routine service calls shall be during the normal eight (8) hour working day, as designated by the Government contracted agency. Emergency service calls will be acknowledged and responded to at hours other than the recognized eight (8) hour working day.

5.2 TWENTY FOUR HOUR CUSTOMER SERVICE NUMBER: The Contractor shall maintain a manned twenty-four (24) hour nationwide customer service number, twenty-four hours per day, including all Federal and State recognized holidays, three hundred sixty-five (365) days per year.

6. REPAIRS DUE TO GOVERNMENT NEGLIGENCE: Any piece of rental equipment requiring repairs determined to be damaged by the requester beyond normal wear and tear as a result of operator negligence and/or lack of reasonable safeguard/security on the part of the requestor will be borne by the Government. All rental equipment will be inspected by the requester upon delivery to user location/site prior to acceptance. Any damage to the equipment including tire condition shall be noted and recorded and brought to the attention of the Contractor's representative at time of delivery and prior to accepting equipment. Tire damage caused by the user shall be repaired or replaced by the Government.

7. CENTRALIZED BILLING AND INVOICING: The Contractor shall provide a Centralized Billing Address that is available to all requesting Department of the Navy locations and or other Government agencies. All orders

submitted to the Contractor by either Government Delivery Order (facsimile transmitted) or by Government purchase (credit) Card shall be made to the centralized billing address provided by the contractor.

7.1 GOVERNMENT PURCHASE CARD: The Contractor shall accept payment issued by Department of the Navy requestors and/or other contracted Government agencies, utilizing the U.S. Government purchase card. Exceeding the maximum limit of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) shall be at the approval and discretion of the cardholder's Approving Official and must be within the cardholder's purchase limit. All cardholders are responsible for following their agency's regulations and guidelines. In accordance with DoN eBusiness Operations Office Instruction (EBUSOPSOFFINST) 4200.1, use of the purchase card to rent/lease commercial or GSA vehicles is not authorized. Therefore, cardholders are not authorized to use the purchase card to order item A042, Pickup trucks, listed in Exhibit A.

8. REQUIRED CONTRACT REPORTS: The Contractor shall provide the Contracting Officer the following quarterly Equipment Activity and Rental Report

8.1 EQUIPMENT ACTIVITY AND RENTAL REPORT: This report shall consist of rental activity for the previous quarter that identifies each transaction and includes the following information. (1) Equipment description and Identification number), (2) Delivery Order/Government Purchase card Order number, (3) Invoice number and date, (4) Rental start and stop date (5) Rental charge, (6) Name of organization/ordering official and ship to location.

9. BILLING CYCLES: Rental rates will be based on rental start and rental release dates. Participating users shall be billed as determined by each delivery order; daily, weekly and monthly (4 week basis) as defined as follows;
 One Day – Eight (8) hour work day
 One Week – Five working days (40 hours)
 One Month – Four Weeks (20 working days-160 hours)

10. BILLING CYCLES IN EXCESS OF ONE SHIFT. Contractor shall provide rental rates for hours of operation in excess of one shift. Actual daily hour meter hours will be used to determine number of billable hours in excess of daily, weekly and monthly rates.

11. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS. Within fifteen (15) days after award of this contract, the Contractor shall furnish to the contracting Officer a certificate of insurance as evidence of the existence of the following insurance coverage in amounts not less than the amounts specified below in accordance with FAR 52.228-05 INSURANCE – WORK ON A GOVERNMENT INSTALLATION (JAN 97). This insurance must be maintained during the entire performance period. Before commencing work under this contract, the Contractor shall certify to the Contracting Officer in writing that the required insurance has been obtained. The policies evidencing required insurance shall contain endorsement to the effect that any cancellation or any material change adversely affecting the Government's interest shall not be effective until 30 days after the insurer or the Contractor gives written notice to the Contracting Officer.

- a. Comprehensive General Liability: \$500,000 per occurrence
- b. Automobile Liability: \$200,000 per person
\$500,000 per occurrence for bodily injury
\$20,000 per occurrence for property damage.
- c. Workmen's Compensation: As required by Federal and State Workers' compensation and occupational disease laws.
- d. Employer's Liability Coverage: \$100,000, except in areas where workers' compensation may not be written by private carriers.
- e. Others as required by State law.

12. COMPLIANCE WITH STATE LAWS FOR VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT UNDER LEASE. Any vehicles or equipment provided under this contract that are to be used on public highways (state roads) must be licensed, insured, and inspected as required by applicable state laws at the expense of the offeror.

CONTRACT CLAUSES – PART I

52.212-4 CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS-- COMMERCIAL ITEMS (FEB 2002)

(a) Inspection/Acceptance. The Contractor shall only tender for acceptance those items that conform to the requirements of this contract. The Government reserves the right to inspect or test any supplies or services that have been tendered for acceptance. The Government may require repair or replacement of nonconforming supplies or reperformance of nonconforming services at no increase in contract price. The Government must exercise its post-acceptance rights (1) within a reasonable time after the defect was discovered or should have been discovered; and (2) before any substantial change occurs in the condition of the item, unless the change is due to the defect in the item.

(b) Assignment. The Contractor or its assignee may assign its rights to receive payment due as a result of performance of this contract to a bank, trust company, or other financing institution, including any Federal lending agency in accordance with the Assignment of Claims Act (31 U.S.C. 3727). However, when a third party makes payment (e.g., use of the Governmentwide commercial purchase card), the Contractor may not assign its rights to receive payment under this contract.

(c) Changes. Changes in the terms and conditions of this contract may be made only by written agreement of the parties.

(d) Disputes. This contract is subject to the Contract Disputes Act of 1978, as amended (41 U.S.C. 601-613). Failure of the parties to this contract to reach agreement on any request for equitable adjustment, claim, appeal or action arising under or relating to this contract shall be a dispute to be resolved in accordance with the clause at FAR 52.233-1, Disputes, which is incorporated herein by reference. The Contractor shall proceed diligently with performance of this contract, pending final resolution of any dispute arising under the contract.

(e) Definitions. The clause at FAR 52.202-1, Definitions, is incorporated herein by reference.

(f) Excusable delays. The Contractor shall be liable for default unless nonperformance is caused by an occurrence beyond the reasonable control of the Contractor and without its fault or negligence such as, acts of God or the public enemy, acts of the Government in either its sovereign or contractual capacity, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, unusually severe weather, and delays of common carriers. The Contractor shall notify the Contracting Officer in writing as soon as it is reasonably possible after the commencement or any excusable delay, setting for the full particulars in connection therewith, shall remedy such occurrence with all reasonable dispatch and shall promptly give written notice to the Contracting Officer of the cessation of such occurrence.

(g) Invoice. (1) The Contractor shall submit an original invoice and three copies (or electronic invoice, if authorized) to the address designated in the contract to receive invoices. An invoice must include--

- (i) Name and address of the Contractor;
- (ii) Invoice date and number;
- (iii) Contract number, contract line item number and, if applicable, the order number;
- (iv) Description, quantity, unit of measure, unit price and extended price of the items delivered;
- (v) Shipping number and date of shipment, including the bill of lading number and weight of shipment if shipped on Government bill of lading;
- (vi) Terms of any discount for prompt payment offered;
- (vii) Name and address of official to whom payment is to be sent;
- (viii) Name, title, and phone number of person to notify in event of defective invoice; and
- (ix) Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN). The Contractor shall include its TIN on the invoice only if required elsewhere in this contract.

(x) Electronic funds transfer (EFT) banking information.

(A) The Contractor shall include EFT banking information on the invoice only if required elsewhere in this contract.

(B) If EFT banking information is not required to be on the invoice, in order for the invoice to be a proper invoice, the Contractor shall have submitted correct EFT banking information in accordance with the applicable solicitation provision, contract clause (e.g., 52.232-33, Payment by Electronic Funds Transfer--Central Contractor Registration, or 52.232-34, Payment by Electronic Funds Transfer--Other Than Central Contractor Registration), or applicable agency procedures.

(C) EFT banking information is not required if the Government waived the requirement to pay by EFT.

(2) Invoices will be handled in accordance with the Prompt Payment Act (31 U.S.C. 3903) and Office of Management and Budget (OMB) prompt payment regulations at 5 CFR part 1315.

(h) Patent indemnity. The Contractor shall indemnify the Government and its officers, employees and agents against liability, including costs, for actual or alleged direct or contributory infringement of, or inducement to infringe, any United States or foreign patent, trademark or copyright, arising out of the performance of this contract, provided the Contractor is reasonably notified of such claims and proceedings.

(i) Payment. Payment shall be made for items accepted by the Government that have been delivered to the delivery destinations set forth in this contract. The Government will make payment in accordance with the Prompt Payment Act (31 U.S.C. 3903) and OMB prompt payment regulations at 5 CFR part 1315. If the Government makes payment by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT), see 52.212-5(b) for the appropriate EFT clause. In connection with any discount offered for early payment, time shall be computed from the date of the invoice. For the purpose of computing the discount earned, payment shall be considered to have been made on the date which appears on the payment check or the specified payment date if an electronic funds transfer payment is made.

(j) Risk of loss. Unless the contract specifically provides otherwise, risk of loss or damage to the supplies provided under this contract shall remain with the Contractor until, and shall pass to the Government upon:

(1) Delivery of the supplies to a carrier, if transportation is f.o.b. origin; or

(2) Delivery of the supplies to the Government at the destination specified in the contract, if transportation is f.o.b. destination.

(k) Taxes. The contract price includes all applicable Federal, State, and local taxes and duties.

(l) Termination for the Government's convenience. The Government reserves the right to terminate this contract, or any part hereof, for its sole convenience. In the event of such termination, the Contractor shall immediately stop all work hereunder and shall immediately cause any and all of its suppliers and subcontractors to cease work. Subject to the terms of this contract, the Contractor shall be paid a percentage of the contract price reflecting the percentage of the work performed prior to the notice of termination, plus reasonable charges the Contractor can demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Government using its standard record keeping system, have resulted from the termination. The Contractor shall not be required to comply with the cost accounting standards or contract cost principles for this purpose. This paragraph does not give the Government any right to audit the Contractor's records. The Contractor shall not be paid for any work performed or costs incurred which reasonably could have been avoided.

(m) Termination for cause. The Government may terminate this contract, or any part hereof, for cause in the event of any default by the Contractor, or if the Contractor fails to comply with any contract terms and conditions, or fails to provide the Government, upon request, with adequate assurances of future performance. In the event of termination for cause, the Government shall not be liable to the Contractor for any amount for supplies or services not accepted, and the Contractor shall be liable to the Government for any and all rights and remedies provided by law. If it is determined that the Government improperly terminated this contract for default, such termination shall be deemed a termination for convenience.

(n) Title. Unless specified elsewhere in this contract, title to items furnished under this contract shall pass to the Government upon acceptance, regardless of when or where the Government takes physical possession.

(o) Warranty. The Contractor warrants and implies that the items delivered hereunder are merchantable and fit for use for the particular purpose described in this contract.

(p) Limitation of liability. Except as otherwise provided by an express or implied warranty, the Contractor will not be liable to the Government for consequential damages resulting from any defect or deficiencies in accepted items.

(q) Other compliances. The Contractor shall comply with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, executive orders, rules and regulations applicable to its performance under this contract.

(r) Compliance with laws unique to Government contracts. The Contractor agrees to comply with 31 U.S.C. 1352 relating to limitations on the use of appropriated funds to influence certain Federal contracts; 18 U.S.C. 431 relating to officials not to benefit; 40 U.S.C. 327, et seq., Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act; 41 U.S.C. 51-58, Anti-Kickback Act of 1986; 41 U.S.C. 265 and 10 U.S.C. 2409 relating to whistleblower protections; 49 U.S.C. 40118, Fly American; and 41 U.S.C. 423 relating to procurement integrity.

(s) Order of precedence. Any inconsistencies in this solicitation or contract shall be resolved by giving precedence in the following order: (1) the schedule of supplies/services; (2) the Assignments, Disputes, Payments, Invoice, Other Compliances, and Compliance with Laws Unique to Government Contracts paragraphs of this clause; (3) the clause at 52.212-5; (4) addenda to this solicitation or contract, including any license agreements for computer software; (5) solicitation provisions if this is a solicitation; (6) other paragraphs of this clause; (7) the Standard Form 1449; (8) other documents, exhibits, and attachments; and (9) the specification.

ADDENDUM TO FAR 52.212-4

52.212-4 (n) This paragraph does not apply because the contract will be for rental only.

52.216-18 ORDERING. (OCT 1995)

(a) Any supplies and services to be furnished under this contract shall be ordered by issuance of delivery orders or task orders by the individuals or activities designated in the Schedule. Such orders may be issued from commencement of the contract through the completion or termination date of the contract.

(b) All delivery orders or task orders are subject to the terms and conditions of this contract. In the event of conflict between a delivery order or task order and this contract, the contract shall control.

(c) If mailed, a delivery order or task order is considered "issued" when the Government deposits the order in the mail. Orders may be issued orally, by facsimile, or by electronic commerce methods only if authorized in the Schedule.

52.216-19 ORDER LIMITATIONS. (OCT 1995)

(a) Minimum order. When the Government requires supplies or services covered by this contract in an amount of less than \$100, the Government is not obligated to purchase, nor is the Contractor obligated to furnish, those supplies or services under the contract.

(b) Maximum order. The Contractor is not obligated to honor:

- (1) Any order for a single item in excess of \$60,000;
- (2) Any order for a combination of items in excess of \$500,000; or
- (3) A series of orders from the same ordering office within 30 days that together call for quantities exceeding the limitation in subparagraph (1) or (2) above.

(c) If this is a requirements contract (i.e., includes the Requirements clause at subsection 52.216-21 of the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR)), the Government is not required to order a part of any one requirement from the Contractor if that requirement exceeds the maximum-order limitations in paragraph (b) above.

(d) Notwithstanding paragraphs (b) and (c) above, the Contractor shall honor any order exceeding the maximum order limitations in paragraph (b), unless that order (or orders) is returned to the ordering office within 3 days after

issuance, with written notice stating the Contractor's intent not to ship the item (or items) called for and the reasons. Upon receiving this notice, the Government may acquire the supplies or services from another source.

52.216-22 INDEFINITE QUANTITY (OCT 1995)

(a) This is an indefinite-quantity contract for the supplies or services specified, and effective for the period stated, in the Schedule. The quantities of supplies and services specified in the Schedule are estimates only and are not purchased by this contract.

(b) Delivery or performance shall be made only as authorized by orders issued in accordance with the Ordering clause. The Contractor shall furnish to the Government, when and if ordered, the supplies or services specified in the Schedule up to and including the quantity designated in the Schedule as the "maximum." The Government shall order at least the quantity of supplies or services designated in the Schedule as the "minimum."

(c) Except for any limitations on quantities in the Order Limitations clause or in the Schedule, there is no limit on the number of orders that may be issued. The Government may issue orders requiring delivery to multiple destinations or performance at multiple locations.

(d) Any order issued during the effective period of this contract and not completed within that period shall be completed by the Contractor within the time specified in the order. The contract shall govern the Contractor's and Government's rights and obligations with respect to that order to the same extent as if the order were completed during the contract's effective period; *provided*, that the Contractor shall not be required to make any deliveries under this contract after the last delivery order is placed before the contract expiration date.

52.228-5 INSURANCE-WORK ON A GOVERNMENT INSTALLATION (JAN 1997)

(a) The Contractor shall, at its own expense, provide and maintain during the entire performance of this contract, at least the kinds and minimum amounts of insurance required in the Schedule or elsewhere in the contract.

(b) Before commencing work under this contract, the Contractor shall notify the Contracting Officer in writing that the required insurance has been obtained. The policies evidencing required insurance shall contain an endorsement to the effect that any cancellation or any material change adversely affecting the Government's interest shall not be effective-

(1) For such period as the laws of the State in which this contract is to be performed prescribe; or

(2) Until 30 days after the insurer or the Contractor gives written notice to the Contracting Officer, whichever period is longer.

(c) The Contractor shall insert the substance of this clause, including this paragraph (c), in subcontracts under this contract that require work on a Government installation and shall require subcontractors to provide and maintain the insurance required in the Schedule or elsewhere in the contract. The Contractor shall maintain a copy of all subcontractors' proofs of required insurance, and shall make copies available to the Contracting Officer upon request.

5252.201-9300 CONTRACTING OFFICER AUTHORITY (JUN 1994)

In no event shall any understanding or agreement between the Contractor and any Government employee other than the Contracting Officer on any contract, modification, change order, letter or verbal direction to the Contractor be effective or binding upon the Government. All such actions must be formalized by a proper contractual document executed by an appointed Contracting Officer. The Contractor is hereby put on notice that in the event a Government employee other than the Contracting Officer directs a change in the work to be performed or increases the scope of the work to be performed, it is the Contractor's responsibility to make inquiry of the Contracting Officer before making the deviation. Payments will not be made without being authorized by an appointed Contracting Officer with the legal authority to bind the Government.

5252.212-9300 COMMERCIAL WARRANTY (NOV 1998)

The Contractor agrees that the supplies or services furnished under this contract shall be covered by the most favorable commercial warranties the Contractor gives to any customer for such supplies or services and that the rights and remedies provided herein are in addition to and do not limit any rights afforded to the Government by any other clause of this contract.

5252.216-9306 PROCEDURES FOR ISSUING ORDERS (MAR 2002)

(a) Services to be furnished under this contract shall be furnished at such times as ordered by the issuance of task orders on DD Form 1155 by the Ordering Officer designated by the Contracting Officer. All orders issued hereunder are subject to the terms and conditions of this contract. This contract shall control in the event of conflict with any order. A task order will be considered "issued" for the purpose of this contract at the time the Government deposits the order in the mail, or if transmitted by other means, when physically delivered to the Contractor.

(b) Except in emergency situations, only a Contracting Officer may modify task/delivery orders. An Ordering Officer, when authorized by the designation official (Contracting Officer), may issue modifications to task/delivery orders only during an emergency. (c) Task orders may be modified orally by the Ordering Officer in emergency circumstances. Task/delivery orders may be modified orally by the Ordering Officer in emergency circumstances. Oral modifications will be confirmed in writing by issuance of an SF 30 within two (2) working days from the time the oral direction is issued.

5252.216-9312 MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM QUANTITIES (JUN 1994)
