


## Finding of Suitability to Lease

In accordance with ASN I&E Memorandum of 22 December 1993, I have reviewed the Environmental Baseline Survey (EBS) checklist concerning this property. A representative from our office visited this property and observed an Automated Teller Machine (ATM) installed in the outer wall of Building 3443, the NEX, NAB Little Creek. The subject lease for the ATM is LO-0187. A new lease is to be issued and the file number for the new lease will be LO-0438. The EBS checklist for the current location was prepared in September 2003 and no treatment, storage, or disposal of hazardous waste at the site is noted. No change in activity for the lease is anticipated. No known potential for environmental concern exists at the property but the site is within ½ mile of an IR hazardous waste remediation site. The following statement applies to the subject property:

The site is not located within or on an IR site. A check of records indicates that no known release, treatment or disposal of hazardous waste has occurred and no underground or above-ground storage tanks are located on the parcel.


