

Finding of Suitability to Lease

Submerged Land off St. Croix

U.S. Naval Station, Roosevelt Roads, Puerto Rico

In accordance with ASN I&E Memorandum of 22 December 1993, I have reviewed the Environmental Baseline Survey (EBS) and/or related appropriate information concerning this property.

I have determined that a 6.1 meters wide (10 feet either side of the center line of the cable) by 3.154 kilometers right of way off the west coast of St. Croix, on submerged land, is suitable for an easement to G.C. St. Croix Company, Inc. for installation, use, operation, maintenance and repair of submarine cables. There are three separate cables that comprise the 3.154 kilometers. They are the PAC, MAC-Hollywood and the MAC-Brookhaven.

Hazardous substances or petroleum products have not been stored for one year or more or known to have been released, treated or disposed of on the parcel.
