1. As requested in reference (a), U.S. Naval Hospital Keflavik has reviewed reference (b) in accordance with reference (c). The review has indicated that there is no known imminent substantial endangerment to human health and safety for the current site conditions and designated land use.

2. The review of the reference (b) has indicated that lead based paint and asbestos containing materials have been removed from certain facilities and/or tanks at the site. It is recommended that full disclosure of this information be made for future land use planning and to ensure the protection of human health and safety.
