

**Finding of Suitability to Lease
330 Acres of Open Land
At Naval Radio Transmitter Facility, Aguada, PR
For Agricultural Outleases**

In accordance with ASN I&E Memorandum of 22 December 1993, I have reviewed the Environmental Baseline Survey Checklist and other related appropriate information concerning this property.
