

Finding of Suitability to Lease

Interim License to the Department of Homeland Security

In accordance with ASN I&E Memorandum of 22 December 1993, I have reviewed the Environmental Baseline Survey (EBS) Checklist and/or related appropriate information concerning this property.

US Naval Station Roosevelt Roads Building 386 B-Level is used as the AFWTF Range Operations Center (ROC). An EBS checklist completed for this site on 28 Feb 2003 did not identify any hazardous material/hazardous waste items or any environmental issues at this site. Therefore, the following statement applies to the ROC Building 386 B-Level:

Hazardous substances or petroleum products have not been stored for one year or more or known to have been released, treated or disposed of at this site.

It is hereby determined, after diligent inquiry, that this site is suitable for lease to the Department of Homeland Security under the terms and conditions and for the proposed uses described in the license. In addition, the license shall guarantee a right of access by the Navy to conduct environmental studies and investigations and to carry out any necessary environmental response actions.
