


**Finding of Suitability to Lease


The issuing of a license by Security Group, Sabana Seca to the National Institute of Health (NIH) for the installation of a monitoring well is suitable to conform with a request by the Puerto Rico Environmental Quality Board. This request was a response to a request by for closure of an old septic system at the Caribbean Primate Research Center.

The well will need to be monitored for approximately 2 years. This will not impact the mission at Security Group Activity.

Hazardous substances or petroleum products have not been stored for one year or more or known to have been released, treated or disposed of on the parcel.
