### **Consolidated AIMD to be Built at Norfolk**

The Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Atlantic Division (LANTDIV) awarded a \$23.1 million task order under an existing multiple award construction contract to M. A. Mortenson Co., Minneapolis, Minn., for design and construction of a consolidated Aircraft Intermediate Maintenance Department (AIMD) building at Chambers Field, Naval Station Norfolk.

The AIMD consolidation will construct a new two-story building to consolidate all functions related to aircraft intermediate maintenance, which are scattered in several buildings, and will demolish buildings. LP-11, LP-14, LP-32, SP-10, SP-11, SP-38, SP-66, SP-234, SP-234A and V-45. The project is expected to be completed by June 2005.

The Atlantic Division, one of four engineering field divisions of the Naval Facilities Engineering Command, plans, designs, and constructs shore facilities for the Navy, Marine Corps, and Department of Defense along the East Coast of the U.S. and throughout the Atlantic, Caribbean, and Mediterranean.
